Cancellations of applications and/or reservations, petitions to cancel contracts and other notices must be submitted in writing to Jacksonville State University, Department of University Housing and Residence Life, 700 Pelham Rd. North, 117 Bibb Graves Hall, Jacksonville, AL 36265 or via fax: 256-782-5123. Notices of cancellation for the fall semester must be received by July 15 in order for the Department of University Housing and Residence Life to refund the deposit. New incoming students for the spring semester must notify the department of cancellation by November 15 in order to receive a refund on deposit. Notifications submitted to other offices do not comply with this requirement and requested official action cannot be assured. The date which notices or petitions are received by the Department of Housing and Residence Life will constitute the basis for determining compliance with deadlines. If mailed, the date postmarked on the documents will constitute as that basis.

Housing deposits may be refunded if a student cancels housing by:

- July 15th for Fall
- November 15th for Spring
- April 15th for May term
- May 15th for Summer I
- June 15th for Summer II
- For Marathon cancellations see University Housing

Refunds of deposits are not given if assignment is made and the contract is signed, unless the student decides not to attend JSU.

Selection Process for

Panhellenic House

Residents

Applicants will be selected for residency in the Panhellenic House using the following criteria in the order it is listed:

1. Panhellenic Officers - Panhellenic Officers receive first priority when considering applicants.
2. Ratio of affiliations in house - Second, applicants of different affiliations will be considered to keep a ~~balance~~ different sorority affiliations within the residency.
3. Grade Point Average and Activities - Lastly, GPA and extracurricular activities will be considered to select applicants who exhibit high academic standards and leadership ability.
4. 1st Year Freshmen may not live in the Panhellenic House.
